### **Road Rehabilitation & Reconstruction in the CBD**

The Randfontein Local Municipality is in a process of Road rehabilitation and reconstruction in the Main CBD, Toekomsrus, Rural areas and Mohlakeng main roads.

Traffic has been disturbed in the last three weeks due to this development. We are also working hard to patch all the potholes created by the recent storms and heavy rains. We understand the inconvenience and frustration that is created by the heavy traffic jams and vehicle damages which have been reported to the municipality due to the big potholes in the area; we apologise and will put more efforts in ensuring that there is normality in all our roads.

We will appreciate if all the road users and community members could bear with us and ensure our drivers drive safely and with caution.

It is our hope that by the beginning of March 2010, traffic will be back to normal.

As a result of rains, we have also noticed high growth of grass in most parts of Randfontein. Infrastructure department has dispatched teams and will also mobilize community members from wards to assist in grass cutting and removing illegal dumping from identified areas. Where there is illegal dumping, we will encourage community to establish a community parks which will be maintained by the Municipality. This initiative will assist us in discouraging illegal dumping which continue create health hazard for our people.
